A Message from the Head of School.

We have plenty to celebrate at Jubilee Park Academy; here are some of the comments made by external agencies that have visited the school to review its performance this year:

- Relationships between pupils are mutually respectful, modelled on the behaviours of adults in the school—Department for Education 2018.
- The welfare and well-being of all pupils are at the very heart of leaders' work—School Improvement Advisor 2018.

We are very pleased with our pupils' results this year:

- 67% of the Reception pupils passed the Good Level of Development.
- 83% of Year 1 pupils have passed their phonics screening check.
- 66% of Year 2 pupils have met the expected standard or above in reading.
- 67% of Year 2 pupils have met the expected standard or above in writing.
- 74% Year 2 pupils have met the expected standard or above in maths.
- 78% of Year 6 pupils have met the expected standard or above in reading.
- 78% of Year 6 pupils have met the expected standard or above in writing.
- 59% of Year 6 pupils have met the expected standard or above in maths.
- 81% of Year 6 pupils have met the expected standard or above in grammar, punctuation and spelling.

WELL DONE TO ALL PUPILS AND STAFF; AS ALWAYS, YOU HAVE WORKED EXTREMELY HARD THIS YEAR!

We have also improved the school by:

- Installing a new heating system throughout the school.
- Refurbishing the Early Years playground.
- New carpets and suspended ceilings in some classrooms.
- Introduced ParentMail: a paperless and cashless system to communicate with parents.

We hope to continue the refurbishment of Jubilee Park next academic year.

We say goodbye to Miss. Sandhu who has successfully joined the leadership team of a primary school in Coventry and we welcome Miss. Lloyd who will be our Year 1 teacher.

School will begin on **Monday 3rd September** for all pupils.

Year 6 ~ Tuesday 25th June to Tuesday 16th July.

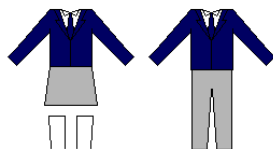
Full swimming costume for the girls and swimming trunks for the boys, and a towel will be required. No jewellery must be worn.
