	Small Group Tuition	£££	+4	This reduces the repetition of curriculum content and ensures pupils make progress regardless of their current level of attainment.	
Nurture	Behaviour Interventions	£££	+3	Our Nurture interventions are more robust than the description provided by EEF. Our structured and regular sessions provide targeted children with opportunities to collectively work in partnership, which in turn develops behaviour, social and emotional literacy. This has been a consistent and highly effective intervention that has supported pupils with a wide range of needs.	Maintain

General Learning	Meta-cognition & Self-Regulation	£	+7	This strand, although not specifically targeting PPG pupils, is well embedded in the teaching and learning across the MAT. Subject leads for Maths and English have supported the teaching staff across the MAT to embed their respective Visual Maths and Talk 4 Writing interventions. This has developed a deeper understanding of the specific area of the National Curriculum being targeted, develops sociability and independence between pupils and engages them in their learning.	Maintain

Health & Wellbeing	Sports Participation	£££*	+4	* Sports Participation is the closest strand that links to 'Classroom Movers'. This new intervention uses the chair and desk that a pupil is working at to complete 10-minute exercise workouts. Summerpark MAT have secured a very cheap price for this software and so EEF's moderate cost rating is actually much cheaper. Research evidence has proven that these exercise workouts, when completed on a morning and after lunch, facilitates better cognitive function of pupils and so more learning and progress is achieved. 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Interventions that we should continue to avoid:

Related EEF Strand	Cost (out of 5)	Impact Rating	Comments
Teaching Assistants	££££	+1	Expensive and generally ineffective. TA's, once left in a classroom to provide 'support' for any length of time, become obsolete. They do not push and challenge pupils to the same standard that 1:1 and small group interventions do outside of the familiar classroom environment. Like pupils, the staff need stimulus across their timetable to keep enthusiasm and job satisfaction high.
Homework (in Primary Schools)	£	+2	Unless this provides a stimulus and hook to a new topic, pupils and parents will be disengaged by completing unchallenging or seemingly irrelevant homework.
